Brian did make some improvements later on to the buildings. Wendell and Gert called them 'Side Track Six.'" Dwight Neff was Wendell's brother. His son Wendell once owned the Healy Roadhouse. Isn't that now an RV park south of Healy?

"He had many rentals and I know of only one that was a trailer, and it burnt while Janis and I lived there," Richard wrote. I remember that fire in the winter. They barely got out with baby Heather.

I'd be interested in knowing more about Wendell.
