DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Provides quality service in the Bowling Center. Issues bowling lanes, shoes, and collects fees. Sells snack bar items and any bowling accessories. Rents lockers and operates all counter controls for bowling pinsetters and related equipment. Collects monies for goods and services. Controls each transaction using a Point of Sale (POS) system. When required, as a liaison between the mechanic and customers. Briefs customers/league president when downtime of pinsetters becomes excessive. Completes AF Form 1875 and all related documentation in a legible manner and turns in all monies and paperwork as directed. Checks the facility when reporting for duty to ensure all equipment is operating safely. Notifies supervisor of any unusual incidents or malfunctioning equipment. Cleans work area as directed in cleaning checklist. When selling alcoholic beverages, checks identification to ensure purchaser is 21 years old. Performs other related duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Practical knowledge of Bowling rules, and procedures, desirable but not necessary. Ability to safeguard and handle cash. Must work well under pressure and be courteous and use tact when dealing with customers. Must be 21 years of age and be able to obtain a Food Handler's Certification and/or Food Handler's Training. Must satisfactorily complete a National Agency Check with Inquiries (NACI).
